Tour Plan: Please remember that all units need to file a tour plan with the council at least two weeks in advance of the camporee.

Medical Forms & Emergency Contacts: Please make sure you bring an updated medical form & emergency contact number for each scout and adult. Annual Health and Medical Record form available on line at Scouting.org. Medical forms will be collected at check-in and returned when you leave.

Food: Troops provide for their own meals except for Saturday lunch and Sunday breakfast (meals provided by Elks Club). There'll be a Cooking Event with the meat provided.

Uniform: The official Boy Scout, Venturer or Cub Scout field uniform (Class A) will be required for Saturday evening flag retirement ceremony. The Scouts may wear Class B uniforms or an appropriate scouting t-shirt for the activities that are during the day.

Footwear: Wear comfortable boots, sneakers, or shoes. No bare feet or open-toed sandals!!

Parking: Troop trailers will be taken to and from your campsite by the Elks staff. Parking will be allowed only in the parking lot around the clubhouse and designated areas.

Campsites: We are only borrowing this land for the weekend. All sites will be inspected before you leave the Camporee for the weekend. Each Unit will be assigned a campsite prior to the weekend.

Fires: Fires are only allowed in above ground fire pits only. Please bring your own wood & fire pit.

Safety: Normal safety precautions should be taken. No throwing of rocks or other objects, no sheath knives or machetes, no liquid fuel or open flames in tents, no unattended fires, etc. All injuries should be referred immediately.

Trash: Please bag all of your trash and police your campsite.

Checkout: When a troop is ready to check-out on Sunday morning, the Senior Patrol Leader should coordinate with the Camporee staff to have the area inspected prior to departure. If your Unit will be departing before Sunday morning please inform Camporee staff at check-in.

SPL meeting: An SPL meeting will be held at the Clubhouse around 10:00 p.m. on Friday evening. ASPL may attend, as well.
